Past meeting minutes had no edits or corrections. Motion to accept minutes from 12-08-22 made by SiSi, seconded by Cindy P, vote unanimous.

Brian B offered his experience and guidance relating to Public Information Coordinator, who is responsible for updates and printing the group meetings directory, assists in events at county street fairs, and coordinates the Ventura County Al-Anon answering service for the public.

Both will forward their documents respectively back to Newt when completed.
